There you will find the Select Grade Resources by grade level to be used by children in Level (Grade) 1, Grades 3, 4, 5, & 6. This will give you the ability to print the At Home Edition from which you can teach the lesson to your child/children. Please, please, please do not just give your child/children the lessons to do on their own. This time is to be spent one on one teaching and learning for both of you. Once you have completed a Session you will need to go to the Interactive Session Review. Have your child/children take the Interactive Session Review weekly and email the results to me. This is how I will keep track of who is completing each Session and when it is completed. Do not let yourself get behind because all Sessions in each Unit will need to be completed before you can pick up the next Unit. The Unit pick-up will be approximately every 6 weeks. One missed Unit pick-up, your child will be dropped from the program and will result in an incomplete for that grade. There are other resources for you to explore with your child/children as well. Please utilize these additional resources. Do not forget to go to the Unit Review at the end of each Unit.

Since there is a weekly Interactive Session Review you will not be required to bring your child for a Check-up. Unit One should be completed no later than the end of the second week in November (November 14<sup>th</sup>). You can pick up Unit Two during the following week. Dates and times will be sent on a separate notice and will be posted on the parish website under Religious Education.

We will not be utilizing RCL Benziger's "Family Life Program" this year. We will be getting a new program from Loyola Press titled "Growing with God". That program will begin sometime after you receive Unit 2.
